Elections Committee Report: Campaign Literature — Linda Gitman reported that the Elections Committee has met to discuss guidelines for the future dissemination of campaign material to members by members. After discussion by the Delegates, a motion was made, seconded, and unanimously approved to bring the following recommendations to the Superintendent for approval: Any literature related to a campaign or contract vote will be created at the person's own expense and not utilize GNTA or GNPS paper or copiers; If the Superintendent approves, GNPS email may be used to disseminate material; All printed material must be sent to the BRCs in each building for distribution; All material, printed or electronic, must be signed by a GNTA member. In addition, Jim Daszenski was asked to establish a GNTA Google Group to facilitate online discussions for issues that concern our members.
